Guest Speaker Dennis Cook

Our guest speaker was photo club member Dennis Cook, who discussed photo composition. Dennis' bullet points were:

- Eliminate unnecessary objects the frame
- Pay attention to texture, pattern, and form
- How do objects work in the frame-Control the viewer's eye
- Use the golden ratio of thirds and the Fibonacci code
- Dennis then provided examples of how the Fibonacci code and the rule of triangles capture the eye. (Using Kim Steeds photo of the rodeo)
- Dennis also demonstrated with a photo of the Delicate arch, how including a person helps with scale.
- Texture, Pattern and Form were shown in the photo of the Oceano Dunes.

We then were shown picture by famous artists that demonstrated these items. Leonardo DaVinci, Helmut Newton were of few he mentioned.
